



From the Pastor's Desk:



After many years of dilly-dallying on account of the prevailing unfavorable economic situation, the diocese of Oakland under the leadership of the present bishop

Most Rev. Michael Barber SJ is finally organizing for the first time in the history of the diocese of Oakland a Capital Campaign for the entire Diocese of Oakland. This capital campaign is mainly to raise money to support the various programs of the diocese with a long time vision and planning. It is also to reduce the debt the diocese has incurred over the years on account of various projects and problems. Last year when we faced a crisis in the form of imminent collapse of our Bell Tower as well as the roof over the dining hall in the rectory, we the parishioners of St. Joachim, as one family rose to the occasion and solved the problems by our financial donations - both big and small.

Most of the people who contributed substantial amount of money to these two projects of St. Joachim Church did so not because they have too much money but because of the love they have for the St. Joachim Church. Many of our parishioners consider St. Joachim Church as their second home. Most of the precious moments of their life have taken place in this church - the Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation, Marriage etc. Therefore, when the church has some need, they feel it is their duty to come to its aid. And indeed you have done so.

Now the diocese comes to us with the request to help the diocese to overcome the problems it faces as well as to support its various programs. St. Joachim Church is a unit of the Diocese of Oakland. We belong to the diocese of Oakland. As an organization, our church has no existence apart from the diocese. We share in its achievements and failures. We share in its concerns as much as we share in its strengths. A healthy and strong diocese will enable the leadership to take initiatives to fulfill the mission of Jesus- to proclaim the Gospel both in words and deeds, to impart our faith to our children and youth, to provide education to our less fortunate children and migrants, to provide counseling to couples who are struggling in their marital relationship, to care for the aged and dying etc. Last few weeks the diocese has been sharing with us a lot of information on the purpose of this capital campaign. Now is the time to make that extra sacrifice. This week is the pledge week. We are called to make a pledge for the coming four years. Even a minimum amount of one dollar per day will make \$ 30 per month and \$ 360 per year and \$ 1440 for a period of four years! Surly that is well within the capacity of all families in our parish. And together with the donation of those generous people who would be making a pledge for a greater amount, well, the goal looks like a small step to climb. Come let us support our Bishop. Come let us support our diocese. Come let us support our Church. "If you love something show it in action."

Nota de nuestro pastor

Después de muchos años de vacilación por culpa de la situación económica desfavorable, la Diócesis de Oakland bajo el liderazgo del actual Obispo Rev. Michael Barber, SJ finalmente está organizando por primera vez en la historia de la Diócesis de Oakland una Campaña Capital para toda la Diócesis de Oakland. Esta Campaña es principalmente para recaudar fondos para apoyar los diversos programas de la Diócesis a un largo plazo de visión y planificación. También es para reducir la deuda que la Diócesis ha incurrido a través de los años por causa de diversos problemas y proyectos. El año pasado cuando enfrentamos una crisis de un colapso inminente de la torre del campanario, así como el techo del comedor en la rectoría, los feligreses de San Joaquín, como una sola familia se unieron y solucionaron los problemas por medio de nuestras donaciones financieras - tanto grandes como pequeñas.

Vatican Corner

This is a continuation of the column on the meaning of some church symbols that are used in Catholic Churches and can be seen at the Vatican. Since the end of the first century, tradition has it that the authors of the first four books of the New Testament: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, are each associated with a winged living creature that was written about in the Book of Revelations. The rationale is that at the beginning of each Gospel a winged living creature is alluded to: Mark is the winged lion, Luke the winged ox, Matthew the winged man (not an angel) and finally John is the eagle. Works of art containing these winged creatures can be seen at the Vatican symbolizing those four evangelists. St. Mark is the patron saint of Venice, and that is why the lion is found in so many places in that City. The Trinity: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit are the three functions of a single God and the trinity symbol is consistently used in architecture and artworks in churches. For instance, many churches will only have three doors: the church symbolizes heaven and the three doors represent the Trinity with the deeper meaning being that the only way to enter heaven is through The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In St. Peter's Cathedral at the Vatican, the Trinity symbol is blended into the main altar. The canopy that covers the altar has doves hovering and representing the Holy Spirit. On top of the canopy is a cross which represents Jesus and much higher up in Michelangelo's dome you can see a mosaic of God the Father in a red and blue swirl shining down from heaven. The use of the dome itself, floating high above the ground is meant to represent the promise of heaven. Many times you will see holy figures holding up their hand with their forefinger and middle finger extended; from there the variations of how the thumb is held vary. Often, this hand symbol is thought to symbolize the Trinity with the forefinger, middle finger and thumb representing the three functions of God. This symbol was actually appropriated from a non-Christian (i.e. pagan) hand symbol of warding off evil spirits. So this hand gesture predates Christianity and has been used in Rome for 1000s of years. Source: Kangaroo.com
