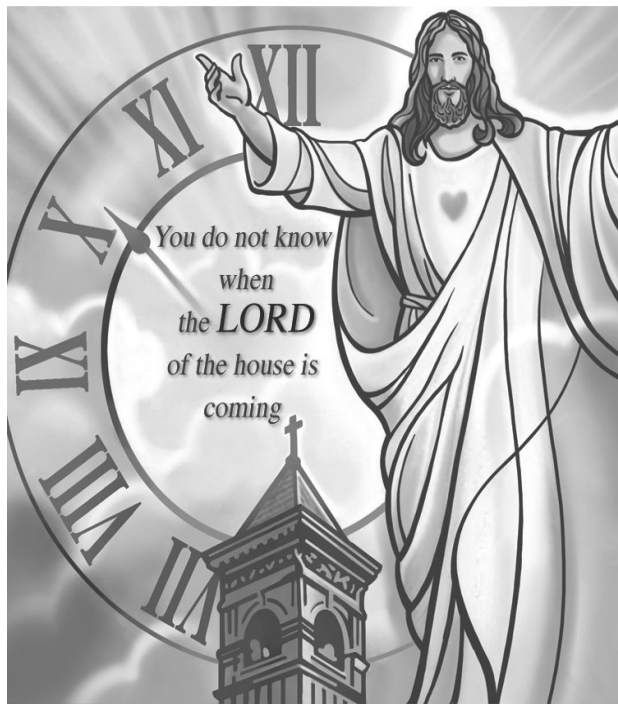

From the Pastor's Desk:



There is a psychologist at Harvard named Howard Gardner who is trying to revolutionize the study of intelligence.

He says that we have been studying I.Q. all wrong. Almost all the intelligence tests the institutions of learning and employment conduct only measure one or two forms of intelligence. Gardner says that there are actually seven forms of intelligence.

1. Some people are gifted with linguistic intelligence, he says. These are our writers and poets.
2. Others have what he calls logical/mathematical intelligence. They make good accountants and scientists.
3. Some people are gifted spatially. These are our artists and architects.
4. Some are gifted kinesthetically. Their bodies are unusually graceful and coordinated. These are our athletes and dancers.
5. Others are gifted interpersonally. They know instinctively how to get along well with the people around them. These are our sales persons, counselors and teachers.
6. Some are gifted in their ability to look within. These are our philosophers "our wise people."
7. Some are gifted musically.

Gardner claims that everyone he has tested so far has scored high on at least one of these seven forms of intelligence. He is of the opinion that all of us are gifted in our own way. Unfortunately many of us go through life thinking that we are not gifted with intelligence. This negative attitude towards oneself gets planted in a person because of the fact that his/her form of intelligence was not valued at the school where he/she studied.

God has created us differently so that different tasks will get done in this world. Imagine a situation where in God created human being only with the gift of singing. Then who would cultivate, who would write, who would dance, who would play, who would take care of health matters, who would teach, who would make houses and furniture etc. Parents and teachers have the important responsibility to help a child to discover the area in which God has gifted him/her and help him/her to maximize that area of intelligence for the good of him/her as well as for the good of the society.

### Nota de nuestro pastor



Hay un psicólogo de Harvard llamado Howard Gardner quien está intentando revolucionar el estudio de la inteligencia.

6. Algunos son dotados en su capacidad de mirar hacia dentro. Estos son nuestros filósofos "nuestro pueblo sabio".

Gardner afirma que todo el mundo que ha estudiado hasta ahora ha tenido calificaciones altas en al menos una de estas siete formas de inteligencia. Él es de la opinión de que todos nosotros somos dotados en nuestra propia manera. Desafortunadamente muchos de nosotros pasamos la vida pensando que no estamos dotados con inteligencia. Esta actitud negativa hacia uno mismo queda implantada en la persona por el hecho de que su forma de inteligencia no fue valorada en la escuela donde él/ella estudió.

## Vatican Corner

In Early October 2014, Archbishop Konrad Krajewski, the Papal Almoner, the head of the department that distributes charity on behalf of the Pope, was talking to Franco a homeless man from Sardinia and found out that it was his 50th birthday. The man had been living on the streets of Rome for ten years. The Archbishop invited him to a Chinese restaurant for dinner, but the man declined, saying that he thought that the restaurant would not let him in because of his odor. Nonetheless, they went to dinner. The Archbishop learned that the homeless man had seen many companions die from the cold over the years. He also learned that the man never has trouble finding food at charity kitchens in Rome, but he does have difficulty finding a place to use the toilet and wash himself. The Archbishop had heard similar stories from other homeless people, where if a facility can be found, it is very crowded and there is little time for its use. Barbara, a Polish woman who lives in a tent with her teenage son and with a companion who is an out of work mason, has explained that some organizations do offer shower facilities to the homeless in Rome, "but there are so many things you have to do. You have to get there at 4 in the morning to sign in. Then only 15 people get in each day. "In addition, because the number of homeless men is so much greater than the number of homeless women, many of the shower facilities are only for men or are open to women only a half day each week. Archbishop Konrad, who had previously considered food as the primary need of the homeless, decided there was no time to lose. He said he is used to acting immediately, without making grand plans, without organizing fundraisers that take months. He said In the Gospel, Jesus always uses the word "today"... And it is today that we must respond to people's needs. So he decides to visit ten parishes in areas of Rome where many homeless people live. He enters parish halls. If they do not already exist, he asks that showers be built, paid by the Pope's charity. They are not expensive projects, they are not designed for large groups, but rather a diffused service for the people in the neighborhoods of a city where public restrooms are closed and the homeless cannot go into cafés to use the toilet. The call went out for donations of money, soap, towels and clean underwear. Acclaimed Italian tenor Andrea Bocelli, through his foundation, made a substantial donation to the cause as well as a firm that builds showers. From those efforts, ten parishes have already renovated or will renovate their public toilets to include showers. Archbishop Konrad also requested and got a significant change to an existing project at the Vatican to renovate the public restrooms at St. Peter's square. On November 17th, 2014, work began that will include three showers for the homeless. The homeless will be able to wash and get clean underwear beneath the windows of the Apostolic Palace.

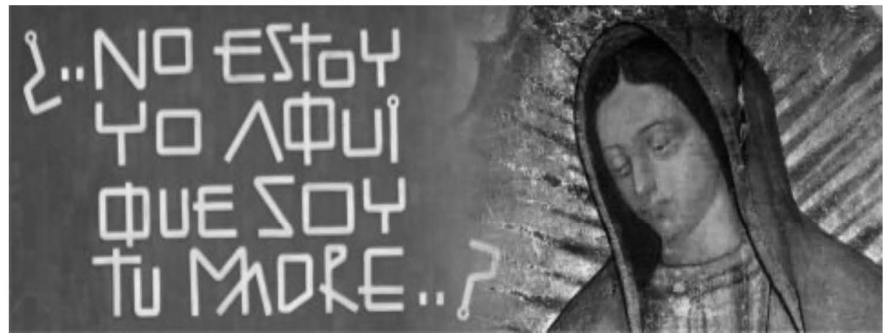
