



From the Pastor's Desk:

In today's Gospel reading we hear Jesus casting out demons. Time and again I have been asked, "Father, do you believe in demons and possessions? My answer to this question is

a plain "Yes". As a priest I have been invited by people to say the prayer of exorcism on occasions they confronted a certain type of force which they could not explain or did not know how to get rid of. To tell you frankly, I try to avoid confronting such situations. Because, the evil forces never like to be disturbed or cast out. And if any one tries to do that, it tries to take revenge on the person who tries to cast them out. Probably that is the reason why many priests either try to deny it or do not want to do anything to do with that. But a priest by his calling to be a disciple of Jesus is called to cast out demons. (Mk 3:15). After becoming the pastor of St. Joachim, I have been forced to confront this situation five or six times. Because the persons who suffered from these 'forces' happened to be our parishioners and I could not say no to them.

One such incident happened soon after I took charge as the Pastor of St. Joachim. One Monday night at 9.15 pm, I heard someone (from Ms. Anita Quarry's prayer group) pounding on the main door of our Rectory. When I opened the door, I was informed that a mother and her daughter are possessed by demons and the daughter is rolling on the ground and foaming in her mouth. When I went to the church, there were nearly 20 people and all were looking frightened not knowing how to handle the situation. I could sense that it is a clear case of possession. I immediately began to read the bible and began to pronounce the words of exorcism. And whenever the name of Jesus and St. Anthony of Egypt were pronounced, I could see the person looking at me with anger. Finally the power of God prevailed. The girl slowly got up and sat down. There after the mother too, calmed down. I called them to participate in the mass on the next day and once again prayed over them and tied the crucifix on their neck. When I asked them, 'how long they have been possessed in this manner?' they replied that they have been possessed in this manner for the last three years. They also told me that they had visited many places for getting cured of this illness but without success.

I happened to meet this girl on two occasions. The first one was when she came to me for confession after six months and the second time was during the festival of Guadalupe. Since her face looked familiar, I asked her whether she had met me any time? She smiled and said that it was from her that I had cast out the evil spirit. To my enquiry as to whether she had faced any problem thereafter, she said no and thanked me profusely for what I had done to her. I told her, it is not I but Jesus who did that for her. And I told her to be grateful to Jesus always for what he had done to her.

We are blessed when we give

Nota de nuestro pastor

En la lectura del Evangelio de hoy escuchamos a Jesús echando fuera a demonios. Una y otra vez me han preguntado, "Padre, cree en los demonios y posesiones? Mi respuesta a esta pregunta es un

simple "Sí". Como sacerdote he sido invitado por la gente a decir la oración de exorcismo en ocasiones cuando se enfrentaron a un cierto tipo de fuerza que no podían explicar o no sabían cómo deshacerse de ella. A decir verdad, yo trato de evitar enfrentar estas situaciones. Porque las fuerzas malignas nunca les gusta ser perturbadas o expulsadas, y si alguno intenta hacerlo, intentan vengarse de la persona que intenta echarlos. Probablemente esa es la razón por la cual muchos sacerdotes o intentan negarlo, o no quieren tener nada que ver con eso. Pero un sacerdote por su vocación de ser un discípulo de Jesús es llamado a echar fuera a los demonios. (Mc 3:15). Después de convertirme en el Pastor de San Joaquín, me he visto obligado a enfrentar esta situación cinco o seis veces. Porque las personas que padecían de estas 'fuerzas' han sido feligreses y no pude decirles no.

Uno de esos incidentes ocurrió poco después de que me hice cargo como Pastor de San Joaquín. Un Lunes por la noche a las 9:15pm, oí a alquien (del grupo de oración de la Sra. Anita Quarry) golpeando la puerta principal de la rectoría. Cuando abrí la puerta, me informaron que una madre y su hija estaban poseídas por demonios y la hija estaba rodando en el suelo y echaba espuma por la boca. Cuando fui a la Iglesia, había cerca de 20 personas y todos se miraban con mucho miedo sin saber cómo manejar la situación. Pude percibir que era un caso claro de posesión. Inmediatamente comencé a leer la Biblia y comencé a pronunciar las palabras de exorcismo. Cada vez que el nombre de Jesús y San Antonio de Egipto fueron pronunciados, pude ver que la persona me miraba con ira. Finalmente prevaleció el poder de Dios. La niña lentamente se levantó y se sentó. Después la madre también se calmó. Les hice un llamado para que participaran en la Misa al día siguiente y otra vez ore sobre ellas y ate el crucifijo en sus cuellos. Cuando les pregunté, "Cuánto tiempo han sido poseídas de esta manera?" respondieron que habían sido poseídas de esta manera durante los últimos tres años. También me dijeron que ellos habían visitado muchos lugares para conseguir ser curadas de esta enfermedad, pero sin tener éxito.

Me tocó ver a esta chica en dos ocasiones. La primera fue cuando vino a verme para confesión después de seis meses y la segunda vez fue durante el festival de Guadalupe. Ya que su rostro se me hizo familiar, le pregunté si la había conocido alguna vez? Ella sonrió y dijo que ella era de quien había expulsado el espíritu maligno. A mi pregunta en cuanto si había enfrentado algún problema después de eso, ella dijo que no y me agradeció profusamente por lo que había hecho. Le dije, "no soy yo quien lo hizo, sino Jesús, quien lo hizo por ti". Y le dije que estuviera agradecida con Jesús siempre por lo que había hecho por ella.

continued ... Pope Francis left Sri Lanka and landed in the Philippines on Thursday January 15, 2015. The Pope said the main reason for the visit was to meet survivors of Super Typhoon Haiyan, the strongest storm ever recorded on land which claimed more than 7,350 lives in November 2013. The Philippines, with a population of 100 million, is about 81 percent Catholic, the largest Catholic nation in the region, and one of the few places where Catholic numbers are growing. On Friday, he met with President Benigno Aquino, and urged the political leader to reject corruption and promote, "honesty, integrity and commitment to the common good." He also called for social justice and respect for human dignity. On Saturday he traveled to the far eastern Philippines to comfort survivors of the devastating 2013 Typhoon, then cut his own trip 4 hours short because of another approaching storm. In a windy and rainy morning Mass with a crowd that included Haiyan survivors, he conceded it was hard to find the right words when surrounded by so much pain. "So many of you have lost everything," Francis told 150,000 Catholic faithful gathered in an open field in the driving rain near the airport in Tacloban, the city hit hardest by Typhoon Haiyan. Many in the crowd wept as Francis spoke, overcome by the memory of the 2013, storm that leveled entire villages with ferocious winds and 21-foot waves. Francis joined them in solidarity, even donning the same yellow rain poncho over his vestments that Mass-goers were given because of the rain. Pope Francis spoke in his native Spanish which he reverts to when he wants to speak from the heart. He broke from his prepared homily and instead composed a brief prayer that began: "Thank you, Lord, for sharing our pain. Thank you, Lord, for giving us hope..." As he spoke, the winds whipped the altar cloth and threatened to topple over the candlesticks. Earlier in the day, the storm's winds tore down scaffolding killing a woman volunteer with the organizing committee. Later, Pope Francis met with the father of the 27-year old volunteer who died. The meeting lasted over 20 minutes and the father although shocked by his daughter's death, was consoled by the fact that she had been able to help prepare for the arrival of the Pope. After Saturday's Mass, a motorcade took the Pope past cheering crowds to an abbreviated lunch with 30 survivors of Haiyan, and then to a cathedral in the city of Palo. Entering without the usual ceremony, Francis took the microphone and told a surprised crowd that he would have to leave right away. He apologized to everyone but the pilots of the Philippine Airlines jet told him the weather would worsen soon. After a quick exchange of gifts, his motorcade sped to the airport in Tacloban. On the plane the soaked papal delegation turned off the air conditioning to prevent them from catching a cold. To be continued ... Sources: The Telegraph, Fox News, CNN, Buzzfeed.com
