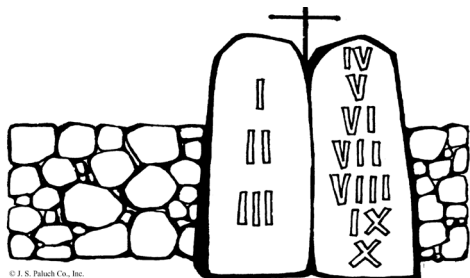

### From the Pastor's Desk:



The Diocese of Oakland under the leadership of the present bishop Most Rev. Michael Barber SJ has begun a Capital Campaign for the entire diocese of Oakland.

This capital campaign is mainly to raise money to support the various programs of the diocese with a long time vision and planning. It is also to reduce the debt the diocese has incurred over the years on account of various projects and problems. St. Joachim church is a unit of the diocese of Oakland. We belong to the diocese of Oakland. As an organization, our church has no existence apart from the diocese. We share in its achievements and failures. We share in its concerns as much as we share in its strengths. A healthy and strong diocese will enable the leadership to take initiatives to fulfill the mission of Jesus - to proclaim the Gospel both in words and deeds, to impart our faith to our children and youth, to provide education to our less fortunate children and migrants, to provide counseling to couples who are struggling in their marital relationship, to care for the aged and dying etc.

We were called to make a pledge for the coming four years. Even a minimum amount of one dollar per day will make \$30 per month and \$360 per year and \$1440 for a period of four years! And together with the donation of those generous people who would be making a pledge for a greater amount, well, we could easily reach the goal set for us. However, the response to this request from our Bishop has been both good and bad. Some of the parishes have responded very positively. They have all ready collected what was expected of them. In a few parishes, the call of our Bishop has not received much success. Unfortunately, our parish falls under this category. The people in charge of this Capital Campaign are unable to understand why a parish like ours which is one of the very active parishes in the diocese has not risen to the occasion of helping the diocese in its need? Why only less than 150 families of the 3000 registered families of our parish have responded to the call of the Bishop?

Maybe you waited for the New Year to begin to make the pledge and then forgot all about the pledge. It is not late. You can do it. As usual I did not wait for the last minute or for the beginning of the New Year. I sent my pledge card as soon as I heard the request from the diocese. I gratefully remembered what I received from God and His Church and in gratitude I wrote my pledge card and submitted it as soon as I got it. Can you not do that? Count your blessings and respond with generosity. I can assure you, you will not regret for doing it. Whatever you do to God and to His Church comes back to you a hundredfold. I have seen it in my life and in the life of my family.

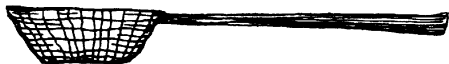

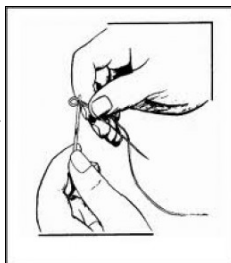

Vatican Corner

Catholics abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and Fridays during Lent. Abstinence is one of Christian's oldest traditions. According to The Catholic Source Book, "From the first century, the day of the crucifixion has been traditionally observed as a day of abstaining from flesh meat ('black fast') to honor Christ who sacrificed his flesh on a Friday," Up until 1966, church law prohibited meat on all Fridays throughout the entire year. The new Canon law In 1983 requires abstinence on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday of all persons over 14 years old and under 60, with some health related exceptions. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops extended this law to include all Fridays in Lent. Since Jesus sacrificed his flesh for us, we refrain from eating flesh meat in his honor on Fridays. Flesh meat includes the meat of mammals and poultry, with the main foods being beef, pork chicken and turkey. Non-flesh products of these animals are not prohibited, like milk, cheese, butter and eggs. Fish has never belonged to the flesh meat category. Fish has historically been considered a cheap, common food, and not associated with celebrations, feasting and rejoicing. Abstinence is a form of penance and it expresses sorrow and contrition for our wrong doing and it indicates our intension to turn away from sin and turn back to God, and make reparation for our sins. It helps to cancel the debt and pay the penalties incurred by our transgressions. Abstinence is also a way to deny the cravings of our bodies to honor Jesus who practiced the ultimate form of self-denial when he gave his body for us on the cross. There are countless options for simple Friday meatless dinners: soup, rolls, macaroni and cheese, fried egg sandwiches, pancakes, cheese pizza and of course fish.

The Red Robin chain of restaurants is hoping to lure Catholics during Lent by presenting its new: Wild Pacific Crab Cake Burger, and has even inviting Pope Francis to lunch. Other fast food restaurants are also jumping on the Lent wagon. The Red Robin company extended an invitation to the Pope to eat at Red Robin during the Lenten season. "If His Holiness accepts and visits at any U.S. location between February 18 and April 2, Red Robin will offer the new Burger to guests for free, while supplies last, on the remaining Fridays during Lent." Around the Lenten season, McDonald's restaurants offer its Filet-O-Fish sandwich for just \$1. The sandwich was created by the franchisee of the first McDonald's in Cincinnati in 1962 in part to cater to the predominantly Roman Catholic customers. A spokesperson said, "While McDonald's Filet-O-Fish is popular year-round, we know that many of our customers especially enjoy it during this season." Arby's restaurant brings back its wild Alaska Pollock fish sandwich every year during Lent and they have a new King's Hawaiian Fish Deluxe sandwich. Their spokesperson said "Our customers have come to expect it, and we are gaining more interest every year."
