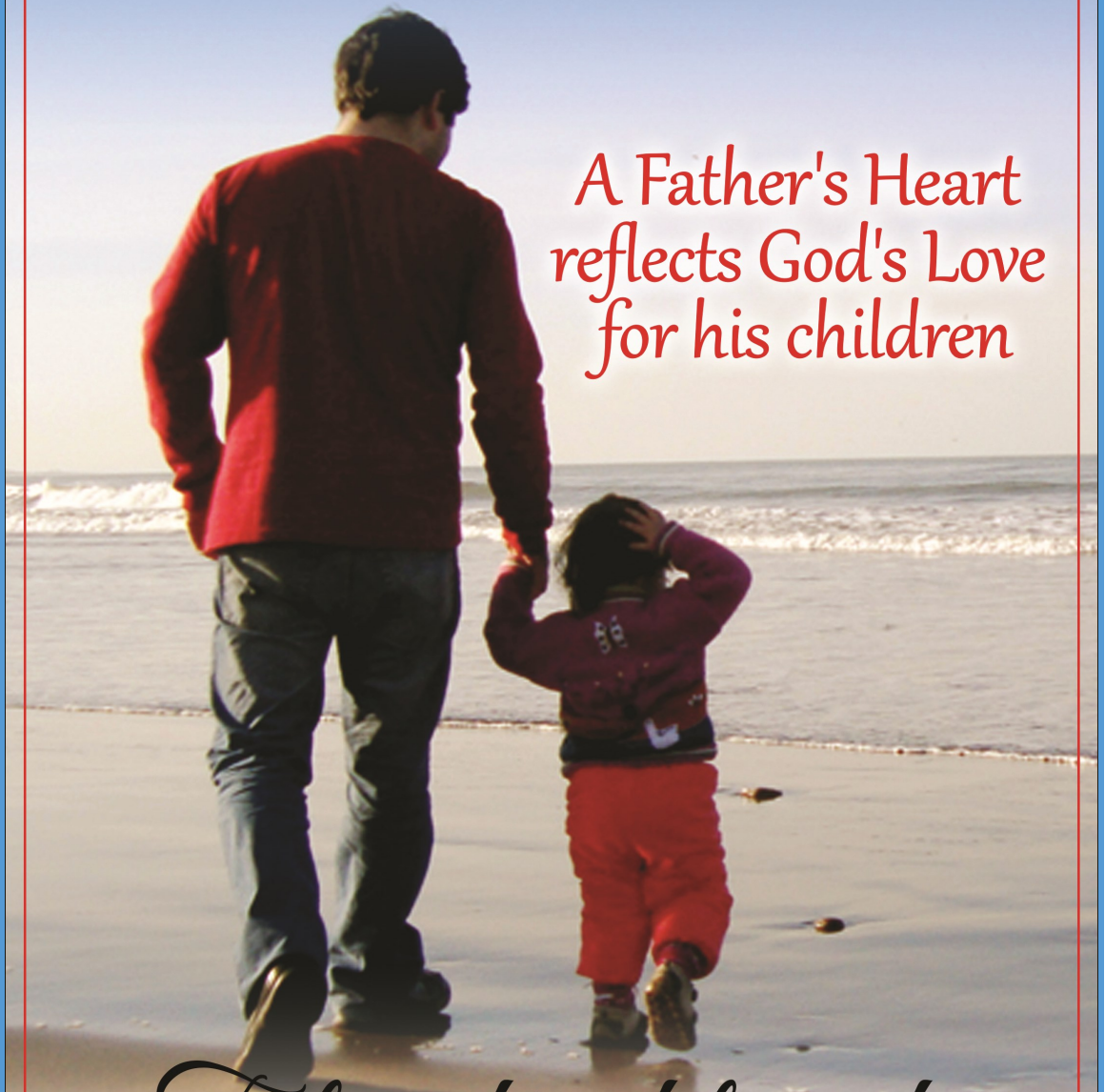

**From the
Pastor's
Desk:**

The 1989 Armenian earthquake needed only four minutes to flatten that nation and kill 30,000 people. Moments after that earthquake had stopped, a father raced to an elementary school to save his son. When he arrived, he saw the building had been leveled. Looking at that mass of stones and rubble, his heart sank until he remembered a promise he had made to his little boy, "No matter what happens, I'll always be there for you." Driven by that promise he found the area closest to his son's room and began to pull back the rocks and dig out the dirt. Other parents arrived and began sobbing for their children. They were saying things like, "It's too late. You know they're dead.

You can't help." Even a police officer encouraged him to give up. But that dad refused. For eight hours, then sixteen, then thirty-two, and then thirty-six hours he dug. His hands were raw, his energy was gone, but he refused to quit. Finally, after thirty-eight gut-wrenching hours, he pulled back a boulder and heard his son's voice. He called out his boy's name, "Arman! Arman!" A voice answered him saying, "Dad, it's me!" Then that little boy added priceless words that dad will remember to the day he dies: "Dad, I told the other kids not to worry. I told them if you were alive you would save me, and that when you saved me they would be saved too. Because you promised Dad, "No matter what, son, I'll always be there for you." Dear friends, how much more should we remember the promise of Jesus! How much more should we rest in the presence

of Jesus, and how much more shall we rely on the power of Jesus knowing when He says we'll cross over, we will make it to the other side!

Four women were sitting discussing their sons. The first proudly stated that her son was a bishop, so when he enters a room, people address him as "Your Excellency." The second, not to be outdone, said that her son is an archbishop, so when he enters the room, people address him as "Your Grace." Nota de nuestro pastor

El terremoto en Armenia del 1989 necesitó sólo cuatro minutos para aplanar esa nación y matar a 30,000 personas. Momentos después que ese terremoto había parado, un padre corrió a una escuela primaria para salvar a su hijo. Cuando llegó, vio que el edificio había sido nivelado. Observando la masa de piedras y escombros, su corazón se hundió hasta que recordó una promesa que le había hecho a su hijito, "pase lo que pase, siempre estaré ahí para ti." Impulsado por esa promesa encontró la zona más cercana al cuarto de su hijo y empezó a tirar hacia atrás las rocas y a sacar la tierra. Otros padres llegaron y comenzaron a sollozar por sus hijos. Decían cosas como, "es demasiado tarde. Sabes que están muertos. Usted no puede ayudar." Incluso un oficial de

policía le animó a renunciar. Pero el papá se negó. Durante ocho horas, después dieciséis, luego treinta y dos, y luego treinta y seis horas excavó. Sus manos estaban angradas, su energía se había ido, pero se negó a rendirse. Finalmente, después de treinta y ocho horas desgarradoras, tiró detrás una roca y oyó la voz de su hijo. Llamó el nombre de su niño, "Arman! Arman!" Una voz le respondió diciendo: "Papá, soy yo!" Entonces ese niñito añadió las inolvidables palabras que su papá recordará hasta el día que muera: «Papá, le dije a los otros niños que no había que preocuparse. Les dije que si estabas vivo me salvarías, y que cuando me salvaras ellos se salvarían también. Porque tú me prometiste papá, "no importa qué, hijo, siempre estaré ahí para ti." Queridos amigos, cuánto más debemos recordar la promesa de Jesús! ¿Cuánto más debemos descansar en la presencia de Jesús, y cuánto más podemos confiar en el

poder de Jesús sabiendo que cuando El dice que atravesaremos, llegaremos al otro lado!

La cuarta mujer dijo: "Bien, mi hijo mide 7 pies 2 pulgadas de alto y pesa 430 libras y cuando él entra en una habitación las personas dicen: "¡Dios mío!"

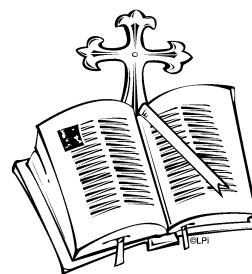

Vatican Corner

continued . . . The Catholic Church remains an important political institution in Cuba even though attendance is low. It helped negotiate the release of scores of jailed dissidents in 2011 and 2012. The Castro government has made major concessions to church authorities since the 1990s. Good Friday and Christmas are now official holidays on the island, and Midnight Mass is broadcast on Cuban state television every Dec. 24. President Obama has removed Cuba from the list of state sponsors of terrorism and the U.S. will reestablish diplomatic relations with Cuba, severed back in 1962. Obama said that Pope Francis helped spur the change and personally thanked him. Cuban President Raúl Castro met with Pope Francis at the Vatican on Sunday May 10, 2015 and thanked the pontiff for his role in rekindling relations between the United States and his nation. Castro said he was so impressed with the Pope that "I will go back to praying and go back to the church, and I'm not

joking." The fact that the man who helped lead the Cuban Revolution would even joke about returning to the Catholic Church shows just how far the relationship between Havana and the Vatican has moved forward recently. Fidel Castro and Raul his younger brother by 5 year were both baptized as Catholics but never practiced their religion. Both were kicked out of their local school for bad behavior and both went on to be educated in a private Jesuit boarding school. Unlike his brother, Raul was not much interested in studies. After years of revolution, the Cuban government was overthrown and Fidel took power. Raúl acted as an executioner during the Revolution and afterwards. He was known for his ruthlessness and brutality and has been one of Cuba's top-ranking military officers. Most of his life was spent under the shadow of his elder brother and he was always seen as the right hand of Fidel. The key role Pope Francis played in encouraging talks between Presidents Barack

Obama and Raul Castro left fractures among older Catholic in South Florida, where the Castro brothers are equated with the devil. Many Catholics worldwide have expressed pride in seeing Francis stirring hopes of progress in communist Cuba, but some Cuban-Americans say their spiritual leader betrayed them. Efrain Rivas, a 53-year-old maintenance man in Miami who was a political prisoner in Cuba for 16 years said he cried when Obama surprisingly announced a reversal of a half-century's efforts to isolate Cuba. Then, when he learned of Pope Francis' role, he got angry. Miami Archbishop Thomas Wenski acknowledged that some Catholics are "concerned or suspicious," but said many more exiles welcome the breakthrough, despite their suffering. "The pain is real, but the Archbishop said "you can't build a future on top of resentments."

Registration Requirements:

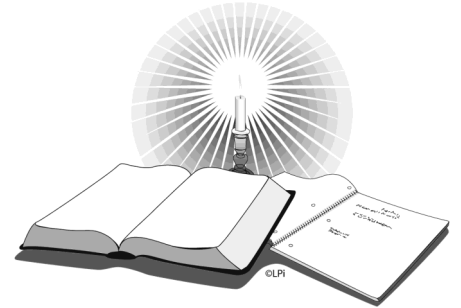
1. Must be a Registered Member of the Parish. Out-of-Parish/non-registered members will be accepted, if space is available, at a different tuition rate.
2. If this is your child's first year, a **copy of his/her Birth, Baptism and First Communion Certificates** (for Confirmation registration) will be required at the time of registration.
3. If this is your child's second year, **tuition for their first year must have been paid in full** and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.

Tuition Fees (same as last year):

1 Child	\$100.00	
Out-of-Parish/non-registered member		\$125.00
2 Children	\$120.00	
Out-of-Parish/non-registered member		\$145.00
3 Children or more	\$140.00	
Out-of-Parish/non-registered member		\$165.00

There will be a \$10 discount if you register and pay your tuition in full on any of the above registration dates. Late registrations (after 6/30) will be accepted if space is available. **There will be a \$10 late fee assessed on late registrations. Tuition MUST be paid in full at the time of registration.**

If needed, payment plan is available — a 50% deposit will be required at the time of registration.
