



From the Pastor's Desk:

In 1991 an Air Canada flight ran into big trouble. Passengers were enjoying an in-flight movie on the Boeing 767 when the jumbo jet's massive engines abruptly stopped. At first only those without earphones on noticed anything.

However, soon it was apparent the jet was in trouble. The pilot came on the speaker system and announced that Flight 143 would be making an emergency landing in a nearby aerodrome. The 69 people on board were trapped in an agonizingly slow but inescapable descent to earth. For several minutes a desperate silence hung over the cabin. Then fear gave way to screams of anxiety as the landing neared. All the latest technology could not keep the jumbo jet in the air. What had happened was this. The electronic digital fuel gauge was out of order. So the flight crew had depended on the figures given them by the refueling crew before takeoff. But someone on the refueling crew had confused pounds with kilograms. Therefore, eight hundred miles short of its destination, that mighty jet simply ran out of fuel and was forced to make an emergency landing. Fortunately no one was injured. A multimillion-dollar airplane, headed in the right direction, but running out of fuel – that's what's happening to a lot of people today. They have everything in life going for them -- a new car, a wonderful home, a good education, and a good job -- and one day they wake up out of fuel. At the center of their lives there is emptiness. They don't know why they are living. There is nothing outside of themselves to live for. Don't let that happen to you. Jesus tells us that the power for successful living comes from God. It is the promised gift that Jesus offers us. "Peace be with you," he says. "My peace I give to you, not as the world gives you. Let not your hearts be troubled, believe in God, believe also in me."

A lawyer's dog, running around town unleashed, heads for a butcher shop and steals a roast. The butcher goes to the lawyer's office and asks, "If a dog running unleashed steals a piece of meat from my store, do I have a right to demand payment for the meat from the dog's owner?" The lawyer answers, "Absolutely." "Then you owe me \$8.50. Your dog was loose and stole a roast from me today." The lawyer, without a word, writes the butcher a check for \$8.50. The butcher, with a feeling of satisfaction, leaves. Three days later, the butcher finds a bill from the lawyer for \$100--for consultation.

A lawyer and a Pope die at the same time and go up to Heaven together. After they've been there awhile, the Pope notices that the lawyer gets a little better treatment than he does. So he calls St. Peter over to ask him and says, "You know that lawyer I came up here with? Well, I'm not complaining, but he seems to be treated a little better than I am... he's got a better house and more servants. I don't understand. I was a Pope and served God all my life; this guy was just a lawyer. What gives?" St. Peter responded, "You have to understand - we get Popes all the time; this is the first lawyer we've ever had."

Nota de nuestro pastor:

En 1991 un vuelo de Air Canada tuvo grandes problemas. Los

pasajeros estaban disfrutando de una película durante el vuelo en Boeing 767 cuando los motores masivos del jet jumbo se detuvieron abruptamente. Al principio sólo aquellos sin auriculares lo notaron. Sin embargo, pronto fue evidente que el jet estaba en problemas. El piloto anunció en el sistema de altavoces que el vuelo 143 estaría haciendo un aterrizaje de emergencia en un aeródromo cercano. Las 69 personas a bordo fueron atrapadas angustiosamente en un lento pero inevitable descenso a la tierra. Por varios minutos un silencio desesperado cayó sobre la cabina.

Entonces el miedo dio paso a gritos de ansiedad cuando el aterrizaje se acercaba. Toda la tecnología moderna no pudo mantener el jumbo jet en el aire. Lo que había pasado era esto. El indicador de combustible digital electrónico estaba fuera de servicio. Así que la tripulación había dependido de las cifras dadas por el equipo de reabastecimiento de combustible antes del despegue. Pero alguien en el equipo de reabastecimiento de combustible había confundido libras con kilogramos. Por lo tanto, ochocientas millas antes de su destino, el majestuoso jet simplemente se quedó sin combustible y fue obligado a realizar un aterrizaje de emergencia. Afortunadamente nadie resultó herido. Un avión de varios millones de dólares, dirigido en la dirección correcta, se quedó sin combustible – eso es lo que le está pasando a mucha gente hoy en día. Tienen todo lo que la vida da para ellos -- un coche nuevo, una casa maravillosa, una buena educación y un buen trabajo -- y un día se despiertan sin combustible. En el centro de sus vidas, hay un vacío. No saben por qué viven. No hay nada fuera de sí mismos para vivir. No dejes que eso te suceda a ti. Jesús nos dice que el poder para una vida exitosa viene de Dios. Es el regalo prometido que Jesús nos ofrece. "La paz este con vosotros", dice. "Mi paz os doy, no como el mundo la da. Que el corazón no se turbe, cree en Dios, creed también en mí".






VATICAN CORNER

continued ...The Swiss have historically been famous for mercenary soldiers.

Switzerland was a poor country and its young men often sought their fortunes in other countries. The Swiss soldier had a reputation for discipline and loyalty, and they were trained in revolutionary battle tactics. They fought with pikes in square formations, but unlike other troops they could move rapidly and effectively with their pikes in order to engage enemies before becoming easy targets for crossbow men. Also they could easily turn to face attacking cavalry. The Swiss were considered the most powerful troops of the 15th century. They served in small units as palace guards, body guards and ceremonial troops at foreign European courts. But the Swiss were also regular line troops in various armies including France, Spain and Naples. The Vatican's Swiss Guard was formed in 1506 when Pope Julius II asked the Swiss leadership to provide him a constant corps of 200 Swiss

mercenaries. The Guard has varied greatly in size over the years and has even been disbanded for a time. The most significant military engagement of the Vatican's Swiss Guard was in 1527 when 147 of the 189 Guards including their commander, died fighting the troops of the Holy Roman Emperor Charles V during the Sack of Rome. Pope Clement VII had given his support to the kingdom of France to try and alter the balance of power in the region and free the Papacy from domination by the Holy Roman Empire. The French were defeated in Italy by the army of the Holy Roman Emperor, mainly German mercenaries, but without their pay, that army mutinied and turned on Rome to sack and pillage the city. The Papal capital was viewed as an easy target and some soldiers who followed

the Protestant movement also saw the city as a target for religious reasons. On the steps of St. Peter's Basilica, almost the entire Swiss Guard was killed. Today the last stand battlefield is located on the left side of the Basilica close to the German Graveyard. Of the 189 Guards, 42 were able to survive to ensure Pope Clement VII escape to safety through the Passetto (small passage). It is a secret covered stone corridor on top of a tall wall which still links the Vatican City to Castel Sant'Angelo, a refuge for popes behind its ramparts. Today a Swiss Guard has his quarters at the top of the stair leading to the Passetto, and he always keeps the keys to the corridor at a ready. The Guard performs many ceremonial duties, but in addition, after the assassination attempt on Pope John Paul II in 1981, a much stronger emphasis has been placed on the guard's non-ceremonial roles. The Guard receives enhanced training in unarmed combat and small arms.




