United in faith and guided by the Holy Spirit



From the Pastor's Desk:

An old beggar lay on his deathbed. His last words were to his youngest son who had been his constant companion during his begging trips. "Dear son," he said, "I have nothing to give you except a cotton bag and a dirty bronze bowl

which I got in my younger days from the junk yard of a rich lady." After his father's death, the boy continued begging, using the bowl his father had given him. One day a gold merchant dropped a coin in the boy's bowl and he was surprised to hear a familiar clinking sound. "Let me check your bowl," the merchant said. To his great surprise, he found that the beggar's bowl was made of pure gold. "My dear young man," he said, "why do you waste your time begging? You are a rich man. That bowl of yours is worth at least thirty thousand dollars." We Christians are often like this beggar boy who failed to recognize and appreciate the value of his bowl. We fail to appreciate the infinite worth of the Holy Spirit living within each of us, sharing His gifts and fruits and charisms with us. On this major feast day, we are invited to experience and appreciate the transforming, sanctifying and strengthening presence of the Holy Spirit within us. This is also a day to renew the promises made to God during our Baptism and Confirmation, to profess our Faith, and to practice it.

The gift of wisdom: Four-year-old Amanda was taken to the doctor's office with a fever. The doctor looked in her ears and asked, "Who's in there? Donald Duck?" She said, "No." He looked in her open mouth, "Who's in there? Mickey Mouse?" Again, she said, "No." He put his stethoscope on her heart and asked, "Who's in there? Barney?" Amanda replied, "No, Jesus is in my heart. Barney is in the pocket of my underwear."

The gift of counsel: Just after receiving his driver's license, a Lutheran minister's son wanted to talk about using the family car. "I'll make a deal with you," his father said. "Bring your grades up, read your Bible more often, and get a haircut. Then you may use the car once or twice a week." A month later the question came up again. "Son," the father said, "I'm proud of you. I see you studying hard and reading your Bible every day. But you didn't get a haircut." After a moment's pause, the son replied, "Yeah, I've thought about that. But Samson had long hair, Moses had long hair, and even Jesus had long hair." "True," the father replied, "but maybe you noticed that they walked wherever they went."

The gift of fortitude: A mother refused to permit her little boy to go for a picnic with his classmates. On the day of the picnic, however, she changed her mind and gave him permission. But he sighed and confessed, "It's too late Mummy, I've already prayed for rain on the school picnic day!"

VATICAN CORNER

On his

first foreign trip as president, Donald Trump met with Pope Francis at a private audience at the Vatican on May 24, 2017. Trump's stop at the Vatican was one of many on his trip which included Saudi Arabia, Jerusalem and Bethlehem. There were discussions with foreign leaders about bringing an end to the Palestinian – Israeli conflict, halting Iran's quest for nuclear weapons, a meeting in Italy with the G7 Group of 7 major advanced economies, and a



meeting in Brussels with the NATO defense treaty organization. Melania Trump, the first lady, Ivanka Trump, the president's daughter, and Jared Kushner his son-in-law, accompanied president Trump to the Vatican. In the past, Trump and Francis have talked past each other, disagreeing on issues including environmental protection, building a wall on the Mexican border, and turning away Muslim immigrants and refugees. This was the first time they had met in person and Pope Francis appeared subdued at the beginning, but smiled later after their 30 minute private conversation. According to Austen Ivereigh, the author of a well-regarded biography of Francis, the Pope may be quick to criticize actions, but he rarely, if ever, savages someone personally, even if he sharply disagrees with them. He hates direct confrontation. When Melania shook hands with Francis he asked her in Spanish through his interpreter while pointing at Donald: "What do you give him to eat? Potica?" She looked puzzled at first thinking that the Pope was talking about pizza. But the Slovenian-born first lady then seemed to understand that he meant potica (pronounced paw-tee'-tzah) the highly nutritious Slovenian festive strudel with nuts, poppy seeds, cottage cheese, chocolate, tarragon, and leek or honey fillings. The Pope is a fan of potica and he regularly asks visitors from Slovenia about the roll cake. Melania Trump's spokeswoman recently confirmed that Melania is a Catholic. That makes her the first Catholic to live in the White House since the Kennedys. It is unclear when she became Catholic since she and her sister were not baptized as infants and didn't make their First Holy Communion along with other kids their age. In order to work, their father joined the Communist Party in Slovenia, and the Party did not believe in God. The Trumps were married at an Episcopal Church in Palm Beach Florida in 2005 and the president is a life-long Presbyterian. Pope Francis blessed a rosary for Melania at the meeting.
